

Benedictine Scholar's Interview Day

8:30 AM – 1:30 PM

BEGINNING

Incoming students are invited to join Saint Martin's for Benedictine Scholar's Day! Students will arrive on campus and listen to a short presentation and introduction by the University.

Shortly following, parents will be directed to informational breakout sessions, while students will prepare for interviews to begin.

Students will be put into small groups of 3-8 other prospects to be interviewed by one current scholar and one faculty/staff representative. Typically, you will be with similar announced majors.

MAIN EVENT

Around 9:30, the traditional interview will begin and is a group setting where students are each given time to answer around 10 questions.

Following the interviews, students will be given a short writing prompt and around 10-30 minutes to complete it.

Next, the group of students will come together for a group activity, typically centered around leadership. Prompt may vary each year.

The interviews are over at this point, and students will be directed to a campus tour with the Admissions Team. Families are free to join at this point.

After the tours, students and families are encouraged to stay for lunch, a Scholars Panel, and an Open House to hear more about the BSP Program and Saint Martin's University. The Panel will consist of a few current scholars eager to answer any questions about the program.
