## Military Tuition Assistance Schedule for Returning Unearned TA

The Department of Defense requires that schools return any unearned TA funds on a proportional basis through at least the 60% completion portion of the course regardless of the reason for withdrawal. Any unearned funds returned, go directly to the military service and not to the service member. Any adjustments to TA funds may leave a balance. This unpaid balance is the responsibility of the student.
