

Exceptions to required placement exams

AP English: Students who have successfully passed the AP English Language/Composition exam with a score of 4 or better are not required to complete the English placement exam.

AP Math: Students who have successfully passed the AP Calculus AB exam with a score of 4 or better or the AP Calculus BC exam with a score of 3 or better are not required to complete the math placement exam.

AP World Language: Students who have successfully passed the AP exam for a World Language with a score of 4 or better are not required to complete a World Language placement exam.

Note: *If you have not received your AP or IB scores, you must take the placement exam.*

College Credit: Students who have successfully completed and earned college level credit in math and/or English through *Running Start* or other high school programs offering college credit may not be required to complete the placement exams. Check with SMU admissions or advising.

Students who have successfully completed one full year of a college level world language will not need to take a placement exam. Students must present college transcripts that show these courses, in order to be exempt from taking the placement exams.
